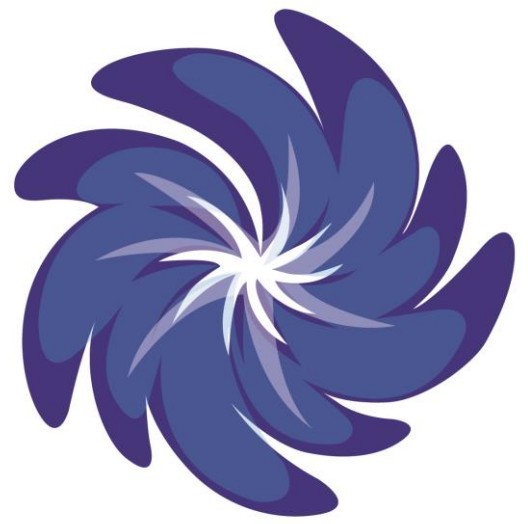


An Introduction to Scholarship Applications
