- Understanding the four overarching domains

3. Implementation Techniques & Tips

- Discussing potential applications of strengths through role plays
- Benefits of strength frameworks for the school community

4. Individual Reflection & Consultation (following course or mutually convenient time)

- Unpacking your strengths report
- Translating strengths into key action oriented goals
